



## "Buying interest extends in the secondary market"

Secondary market continued to witness persistent buying interest amidst the supply constraint following the auction outcome of yesterday which was largely undersubscribed. On the short end, 15.11.2024 traded at 14.25%. Trades were also visible on the mid tenors with 15.05.2026 and 01.06.2026 recording trades in a range from 15.00%-14.75% while yesterday's auction tenor 15.01.2027 and 15.09.2027 hovered between 14.75%-14.55%. In the midst of moderate volumes, 2028 maturities, 01.05.2028 and 01.07.2028 traded between 14.75%-14.60%. Meanwhile, CBSL expects to raise LKR 175.0Bn from tomorrow's weekly T-Bill auction. On the external side, LKR marginally appreciated against the green back and closed at LKR 326.9.




