"Bourse bounces back into the green"

The bourse closed in the green today, despite a mixed sentiment been observed in today's market. ASPI stayed stagnant for the majority of todays session but picked towards the latter part of the session ending at a 39 point increase to 10,691. Aside from HNB, banking sector counters saw a selling pressure emerging in today's session. UAL and CTC saw an increased interest which resulted in a 6.6% and 1.9% price appreciation respectively following their dividend announcements. Further, a mixed sentiment was observed on blue chip counters. The largest positive contributors to the index were HNB, CARG & MELS whilst the largest negative contributors were COMB, DFCC & JKH. . Market turnover was recorded at LKR 1.5Bn, 6% lower than the average market turnover of LKR 1.6Bn. Majority of the market turnover was contributed by the retail market, showing a revival in investor's interest in the Colombo Bourse, Foreign investors remained net sellers with a net foreign outflow of LKRxx.
