

"Slight buying interest emerge in the secondary market"

The secondary market witnessed low volumes as the investors displayed low activity during the day. Moreover, the market witnessed slight buying interest pivoting from the subdued sentiment observed during the previous week signalling market stabilization. Trades were centered on the short and mid tenors as 15.12.27 traded at 11.32%, 01.05.27 traded at 11.90%, 01.07.28 and 15.12.28 traded at 12.13% and 12.12% respectively. Overnight liquidity stood at LKR -36.1Bn remaining in the negative territory for the 4th consecutive time whilst, CBSL holdings remained stagnant at LKR 2695.6Bn at the end of the day. On the external side LKR slightly appreciated against the green back recording at LKR 306.3 during the day.
