"Secondary market flat; CBSL bond auction raises LKR 162.1Bn"

The secondary government market recorded subdued trading activity ahead of today's T-bond auction, resulting in the yield curve remaining broadly unchanged from the previous day. Among the limited number of trades, the 15.10.2029 maturity was quoted at a yield of 9.68%. At the Tbond auction held today, the CBSL raised a total of LKR 162.1Bn, approximately 10.4% below the initial offer of LKR 181.0Bn. The funds were mobilized through the issuance of bonds maturing in 2030. 2033, and 2037, which recorded weighted average vields of 9.80%, 10.72%, and 11.01% respectively. On the external front, the LKR appreciated against the USD, closing at LKR 302.68/USD vs. LKR 302.73/USD seen previously. Overnight liquidity in the banking system contracted to LKR 167.2Bn from LKR 169.2Bn recorded the previous day.
